#### **1.0 Executive summary**

This proposal outlines the vision, justification, and plan for constructing a permanent, purpose-built church facility for family altar prophetic ministries international. The project is a response to our growing congregation and the need for a stable, accessible, and functional space for worship, community outreach, and ministry activities.

This document details the project's objectives, scope of work, budget, timeline, and how the new facility will enable us to better serve our members and the wider community of fortportal tourism city Uganda east Africa .

#### **2.0 Church and ministry background**

Family altar prophetic ministries international was found by the burden for families, as an instruction , through the servant of God pastor Arthur with a huge testimony from drug addiction but also visiting small families. In obedience to Christ call to reach the magnalized, we regularly visit hospitals remand homes , prisons the elderly, babies homes , orphanages and others who are oppressed or in need . Our mission is to bring hope love and light of Jesus to those often forgotten by society

## **2.1 About family altar prophetic ministries**

Mission: Family altar prophetic ministry we are dedicated to spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ his love and forgiveness to all families worldwide, fostering spiritual growth, and serving the communities

History: Founded in the year of 2022 16<sup>th</sup> January with 15members , the church began immediately after the fight against COVID 19 . We have since been operating from a temporary church structure .

we meet collectively every weekend with over 90 people now in kitumba Bugunda fortportal city Uganda east Africa. But we know this means nothing if families are left hungry and alone. Its the love of Jesus that compels us to embrace those hurting in our world this is why we have small family altars in the community, schools hospitals , prisons and markets. This is where we walk beside one another and truly grow as a family.

This growth has placed a strain on our current facilities, limiting our ability to expand our ministries.

## **2.2 Statement of need**

Our current facilities no longer adequately serve the needs of our congregation or the community. The problems we face include:

Limited space: Our current worship space is temporary the timbers and wood have roaten and when it rains we find it hard to worship

Insufficient ministry areas: We lack dedicated classrooms for children's and youth programs, proper administrative office space, and a suitable fellowship hall for community gatherings.

Operational constraints: Our church properties like the sound equipment , the chairs and others are not safe since the wood can be broken by thugs anytime

Lack of permanence: A permanent structure will provide a stable home for our church, fostering a deeper sense of community and security for our members.

## **3.0 Project goals and objectives**

### **3.1 Primary goal**

To construct a permanent, multi-purpose church facility that will accommodate the spiritual and practical needs of our congregation and community for generations to come.

### **3.2 Specific objectives**

Expand capacity: Build a new sanctuary with seating for 200 people to accommodate our growing congregation.

Provide ministry space: Create dedicated classrooms for Sunday school, a nursery, and a youth ministry area.

Enhance community outreach: Include a multi-purpose fellowship hall where pastors and leaders can be trained from , skilling the single mothers , events, and other outreach programs.

Create administrative offices: Establish secure and professional office space for church staff and leadership.

Improve accessibility: Design a facility that meets modern accessibility standards, including ramps, restrooms, and parking for those with disabilities.

Ensure financial sustainability: Construct a building that is energy-efficient and cost-effective to maintain.

## **4.0 Scope of work**

### **4.1 Architectural design and planning**

A qualified architect and Quantitative surveyor experienced in church designs have already done the work and is attached to this proposal

### **4.2 Construction and site preparation**

Site location: The new church will be built on our acquired property located in kitumba Bugunda which was donated by our devine parents Roy Moore and Jane Moore through HELP for east Africa organisation, who are battling with health issues and old age.

Foundation and structure: Lay a solid foundation and erect the main structural frame, walls, and roofing.

Interior and finishing: Install flooring, walls, ceilings, lighting, and necessary furniture like pews and pulpits.

Utilities and systems: Install all mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems, and audio-visual equipment.

#### **4.3 Permits and approvals**

Secure all necessary permits and approvals from we are in plans to meet Local Government, Planning Boards, and Denominational Authorities for approval .

#### **5.0 Budget and financial plan**

Phase 3: Construction from June 2026 we will Break ground and begin the construction process.

Phase 4: Finishing and Move-in as the Lord provides Complete interior work, install furnishings, and prepare for the grand opening.
